- 1. That the Application No. 2744/DELNP/2004 was filed on September 17, 2004 by our local Indian patent attorneys along with a statement and undertaking on form 4 (the relevant Form under the Patents Rules 1972 on such date);
- 2. That in accordance with Section 8 of the Patents Act such form 4 was required to set out details of all corresponding foreign patent applications on file at the time of filing of our Indian application;
- 3. That substantially simultaneously with the issuing of instructions to our Indian attorneys for the filing of the Indian application, we issued instructions to other associates and attorneys in other foreign countries for the filing of corresponding patent applications;
- 4. That at the time of filing of this application, therefore, details of the corresponding applications some of which were already on file when the Indian application was filed were not available to us:
- 5. That in such circumstances, the Form 4 filed with this application could not contain details of all corresponding applications on file at the time of filing this Indian application and such inability to convey details of existing foreign applications constituted an irregularity of the procedure envisaged by Section 8;
- 6. That such irregularity is one which may be obviated without detriment to the interest of any person;
- 7. That because of varying requirements from country to country, there has been a certain amount of difficulty and consequent expenditure of time in obtaining details of filing of our corresponding foreign patent applications;
- 8. That as soon as such details were obtained, we forwarded them to our Indian attorneys who in turn conveyed them to the Controller without delay.

In the circumstances narrated, the Controller is respectfully requested to correct the irregularity in our failure to convey to him at the time of filing details of corresponding foreign applications.
